

## **RICAS Tools and Accommodations Reference Sheet**

The following embedded tools are available to all students.

Icon	Description
	<b>Answer Eliminator:</b> Use the Answer Eliminator tool to cross-out multiple-choice answers on a test. Answer choices may not be selected while they are crossed-out.
<ul> <li>A</li> <li>B point R</li> <li>C point S</li> </ul>	<b>Answer Masking:</b> Use the Answer Masking tool to hide an answer option. This will help you narrow down your correct answer. Click the eye icon again to display the answer option again.
1 • 📩	<b>Bookmark:</b> Bookmark or save items to come back to later by clicking the star icon. The Jump to Question icon is a picture of a down arrow. Click the down arrow to be taken to a test review screen to jump to another test question.
	<b>Calculator:</b> Available to all students for the <i>calculator session</i> (Session 2) of the grade 7 and grade 8 mathematics tests. Use the Calculator tool as you would use any calculator, but make sure you select your answer on the test after using the calculator.
	<b>Color Contrast:</b> Use the Color Contrast tool to change the background color and text color of the test content.
	<b>General Masking:</b> Use the General Masking tool to hide or mask certain portions of the screen; you may add multiple masking squares as well as reposition and resize the squares on the screen to hide more or less of the screen.
abc	<b>Highlighter:</b> Use the Highlighter tool to select text and highlight the selection. There are four colors to choose from for highlighting.

abc	<b>Line Reader:</b> Use the Line Reader tool to move the tool up and down to help you read the text on the screen.
	<b>Notepad:</b> Use the Notepad tool to type notes in the notepad for each separate test question. Notes on passages are viewable for all items pertaining to the passage. The notepad can be moved around on the screen as desired.
	<b>Reverse Contrast:</b> Use the Reverse Contrast tool to invert all color values on the screen.
The state of the s	<b>Ruler:</b> The ruler tool will be available for specific items and allows a student to measure in centimeters or inches. The ruler is partially translucent and can be rotated, moved, and resized.
Screen Zoom:	<b>Screen Zoom:</b> Use the Screen Zoom tool to zoom your screen to 100%, 150%, 200% or 300%.
	<b>Spell Check:</b> Use spell check on constructed response items. Spell check will be available for all students for Mathematics.
